## I. DRAWING EXAM for ALL DEPARTMENTS (Except THEATRE)

Date and Time: 23-27 August 2021, 10:00-12:00 / 14:00-16:00 [Candidates will take the exam at the date and time specified on the Exam Entrance Card.]

Location: Faculty of Fine Arts, Annex Building Entrance (North Preparation Gate, Ring Stop No. 7)

Required Documents and Materials: [The choice of material types and quality belongs to the candidate]

- 35x50 cm Art Paper (4 pcs)
- 35x50 cm Duralite Base
- Clamp or Clip (for fastening paper to duralite)
- Soft Pencil
- Soft Eraser
- Pencil Sharpener

About the Exam: An object determined by the jury that day will be placed in front of the candidates. Candidates will be asked to draw the object that is placed to the hall, from the angle they see and to create a composition by adding an imaginary second object or subject. During the given exam period, the candidates' ability to draw what they see, design and arrange different objects on a surface is tested.

## II. DRAWING EXAMS and PORTFOLIO EVALUATIONS for ALL DEPARTMENTS

- Candidates can choose **only one** program considering their interests and abilities.
- There is no drawing exam for the theater program.
- Information about the day and time of the portfolio evaluation of the candidates will be announced during the drawing exam.

(Any kind of material can be used in this study.)  If desired, portfolios also may contain;  • 5 free/experimental drawing studies in 35x50 cm dimensions, which they think best express their interests and talents in the fields of textile and fashion design,  • apparel, accessories, fabric, textile pattern designs  The portfolio should consist of a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 10 studies.
THEATRE Paid : 10 Scholarship : 5 50% off : 18	23-24-25-26-27 August 2021 09:00-18:00	Faculty of Fine Arts 3rd Floor, Classroom no: 318, 321, 323, 329, 331	In the stage exam, the candidates will present a poem and two tirades (a tragedy/drama piece and a comedy piece) that they have prepared before the jury, the total duration of which does not exceed 10 minutes. Afterwards, an interview will be held to get to know the candidate. Candidates can take the stage exam face-to-face or online.
