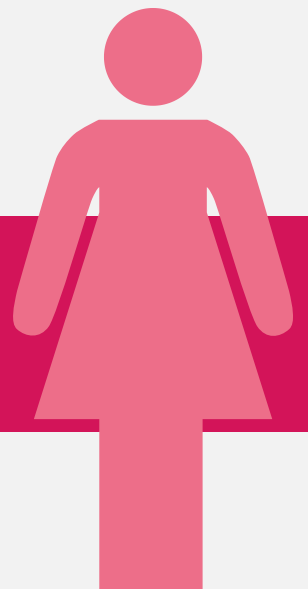
Gender Ratio of Students with Disabilities

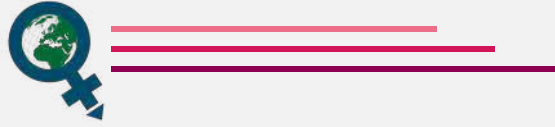
We have **27** disabled students.

48% of the students with disabilities in the University are men

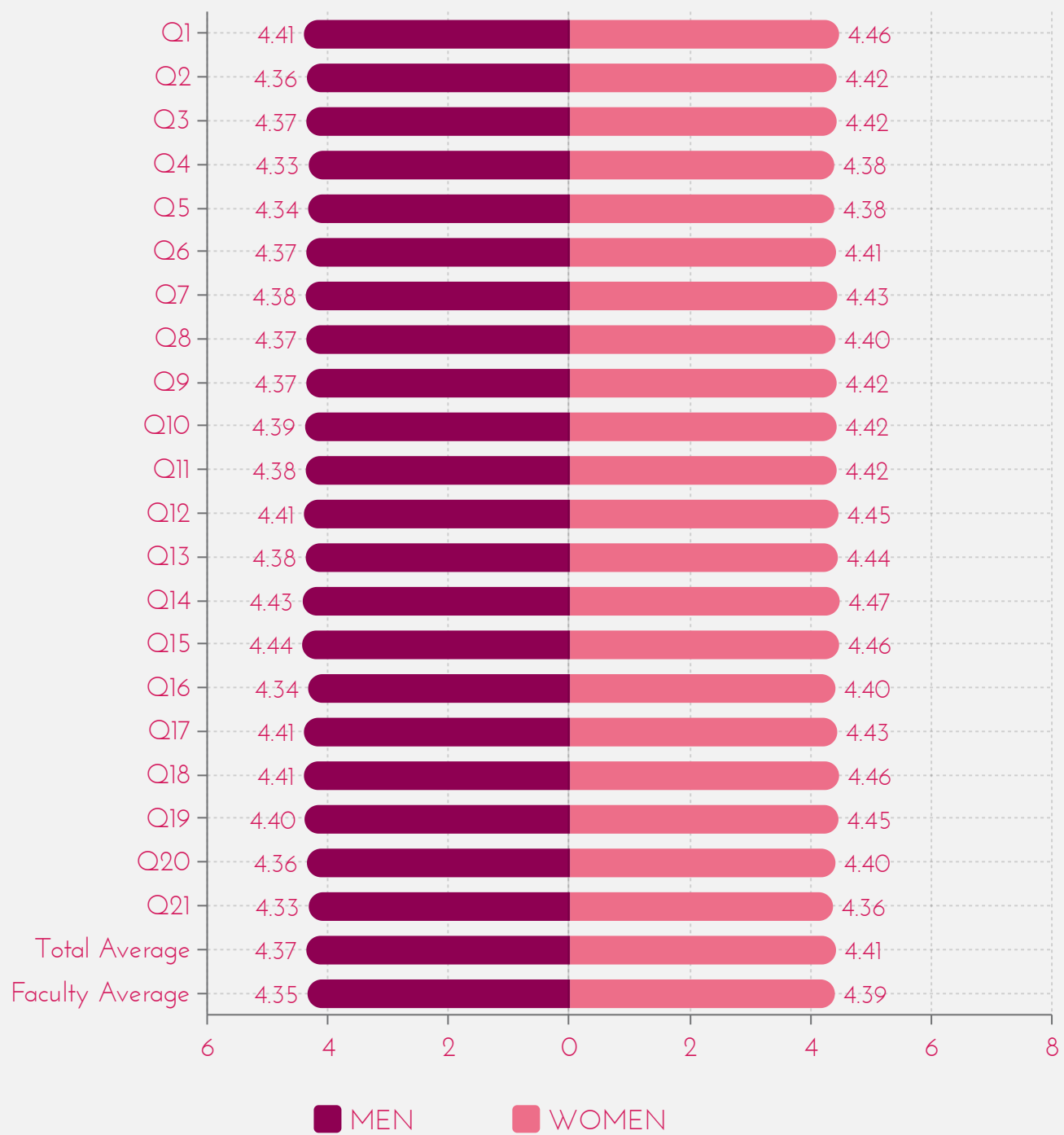

Results of Student Course Evaluation Survey

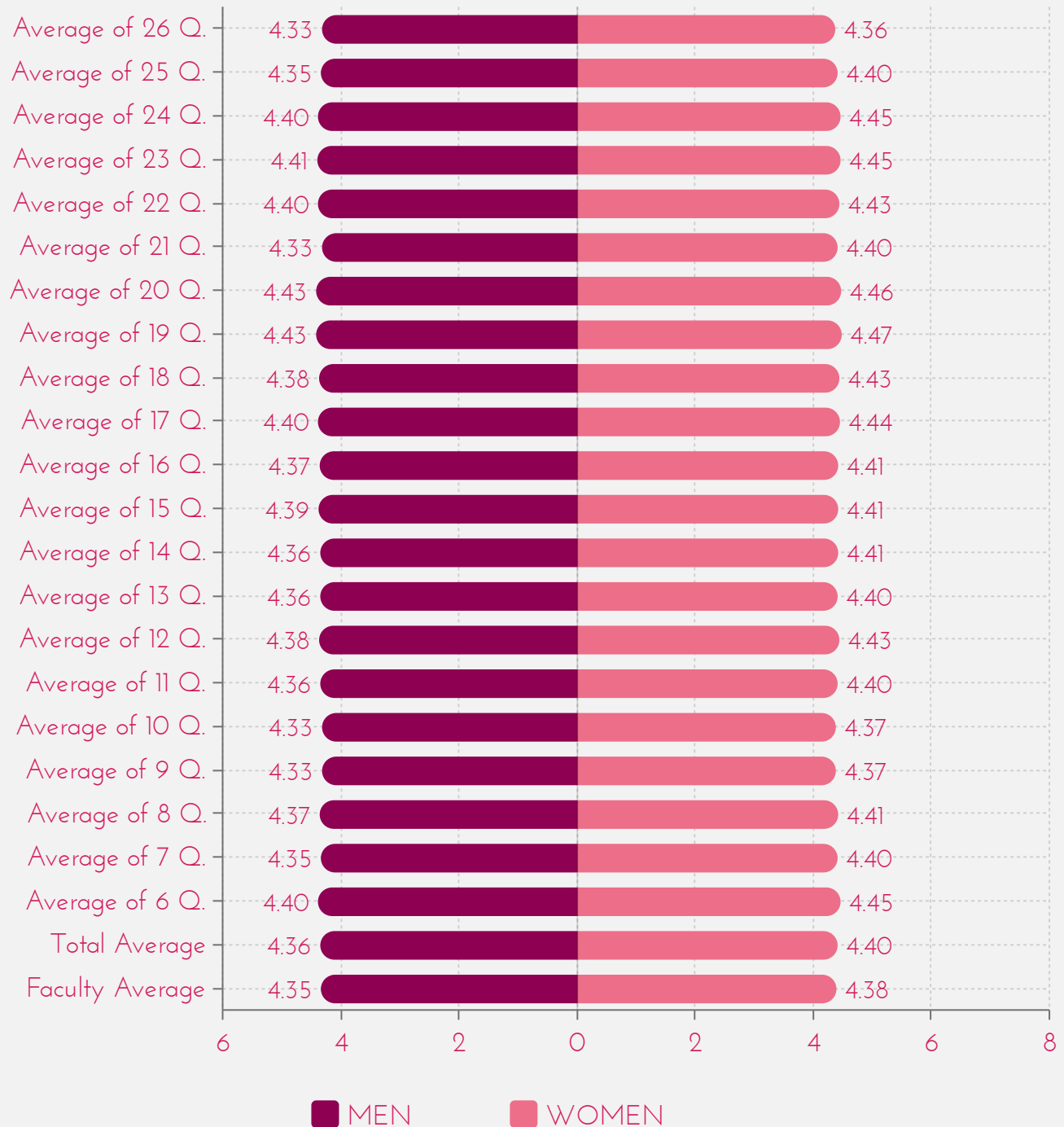
Average Score out of 5.00

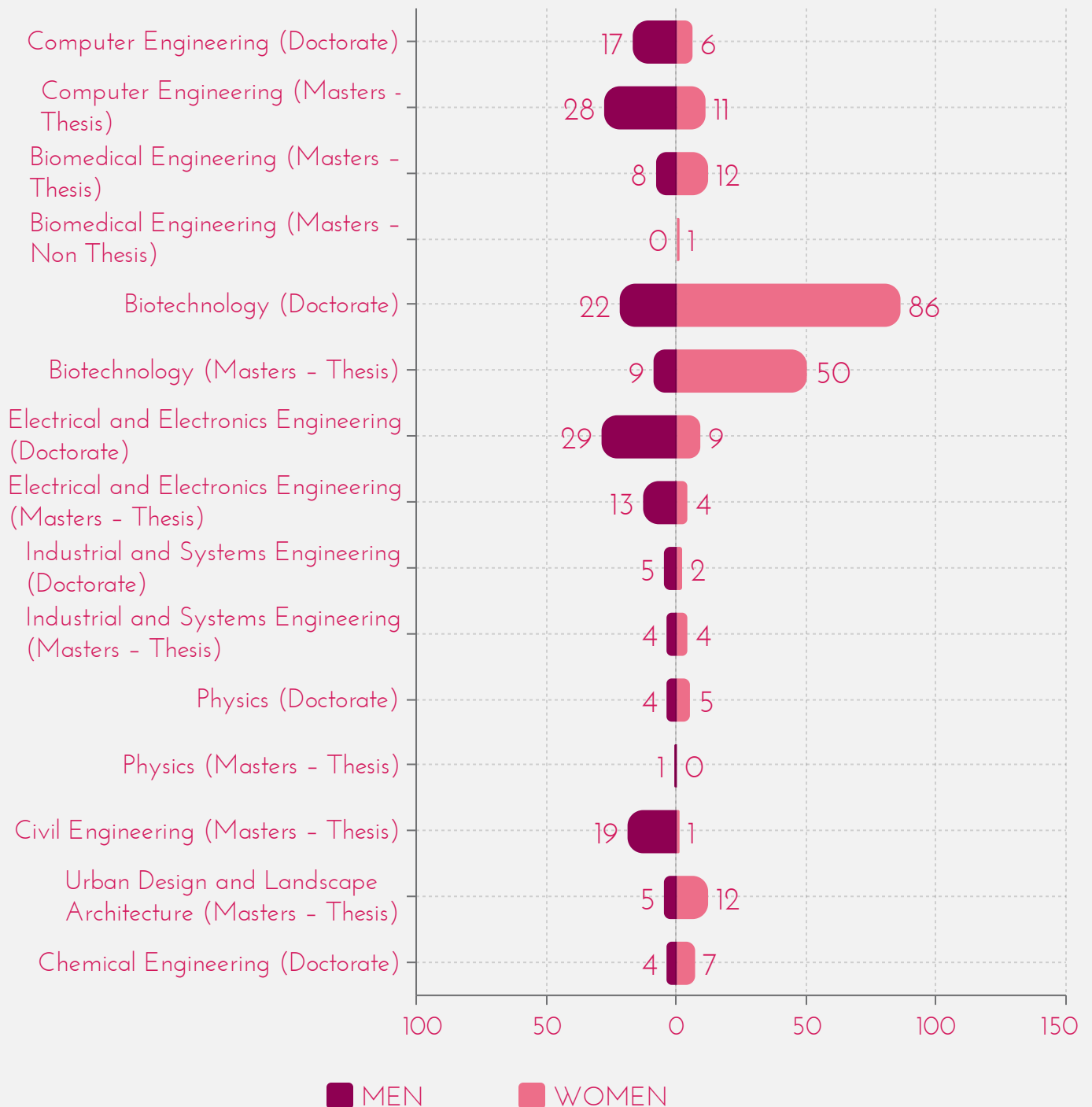
